[6] David Howell Petraeus<sup>10</sup> is a retired American military officer and public official. He served as Director of the Central Intelligence Agency from September 6, 2011, until his resignation on November 9, 2012. Prior to his assuming the directorship of the CIA, Petraeus was a highly decorated four-star general, serving over 37 years in the United States Army. His last assignments in the Army were as commander of the International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) and Commander, U.S. Forces Afghanistan (USFOR-A) from July 4, 2010, to July 18, 2011. He is currently a partner of Kohlberg Kravis Roberts & Co. L.P., a New York investment firm and chairman of its newly created KKR Global Institute.

[7] Raymond T. "Ray" Odierno<sup>11</sup> is a United States Army general and the 38th Chief of Staff of the U.S. Army. Odierno most recently commanded United States Joint Forces Command from October 2010 until its disestablishment in August 2011. He served as Commanding General, United States Forces – Iraq and its predecessor, Multi-National Force – Iraq, from September 2008 through September 2010. Prior to that, he served as Commanding General, III Corps, from May 2006 to May 2008. He is currently a senior advisor to JP Morgan Chase & Co. [9.2] Dept of Justice: Office of the Solicitor General<sup>46</sup>:

- A. The Office of the Solicitor General supervises and conducts government litigation in the United States Supreme Court. The U.S Government is involved in approximately two-thirds of all the cases the U.S. Supreme Court decides on the merits each year. Donald B. Verrilli Jr. is the 46<sup>th</sup> and current Solicitor General of the United States. Supreme Court Briefs are briefs filed to the Supreme Court by the Office of the Solicitor General.

[12] Arif Hasan Akhundzada Khan<sup>47</sup>: is a Pashtun-English descendant of the Siberian Grey She-Wolf Nomadic Ashina clan<sup>48</sup>; with an English mother. He is the Principal at DRC 2: a Pakistan Army De-Radicalisation Centre at Bara. This is an Army institution for local juvenile surrendered Taliban, from the Lashkar-e-Islam militia of Commander Mangal Bagh -- who were a part of the renegade Pakistani Taliban, and operated out of the Bara area of Khyber Agency till 2009, when the Army entered and expelled them. The area was finally pacified at the end of 2014 -- and the Army decided to institute a de-radicalisation programme to undo those effects. DRC 2 is the second of three such centers – the other two being for adult internees – that aim at rehabilitating, re-educating and reintegrating former fighters.
